Church Links

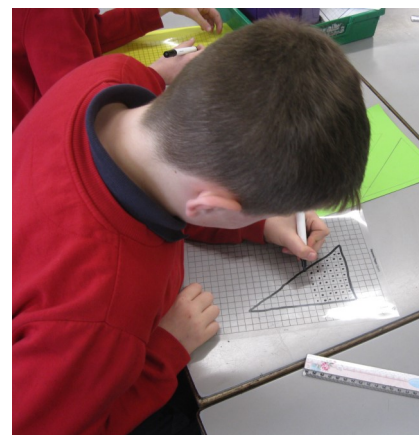
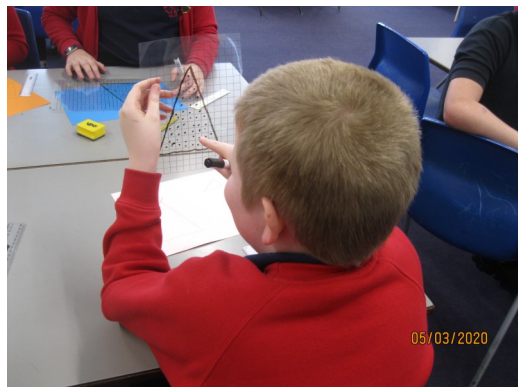
This week in Collective Worship the children learnt about Kindness. In Collective Worship children in Year 1 and Year 2 learnt about the Stations of the Cross.
