



Latest Health Update

Here is a reminder of the latest Government advice:

If anyone in your household develops COVID-19 symptoms

Anyone with any of the **3** symptoms listed should stay at home and arrange a PCR test.

Testing must be conducted within the first 5 days of the onset of symptoms.

If the test result is positive, the person must self-isolate for 10 days.

Please inform school of any absence.

When you receive your test result, **please email admin@elland.calderdale.sch.uk**

with details before your child returns to school. Children can return to school as soon as a negative test is received.

If you have been in contact with someone with COVID-19

Limit close contact with other people outside the household, especially in enclosed spaces.

Wear a face covering in enclosed spaces and where you are unable to maintain social distancing if you are 11 or over.

Take part in regular LFD testing if aged 11 or over.

Stay away from people who are clinically vulnerable as much as possible.

Remember that vaccination reduces, but does not eliminate, the risk of acquiring and transmitting infection.

Symptoms

- *High temperature
- *New continuous cough
- *Loss or change to sense of taste or smell

Please Note

Children with simple cold symptoms such as runny noses or sore throats **without fever** should not be tested for COVID-19, and can attend school if they feel well enough to do so.

We have a selection of good quality coats in school. If you would like to look, please see Mrs Hoyle




We have joined the Millionaire Word club which Miss Richardson launched yesterday.




The children can earn rewards as they work towards reading 1 million words.
