
## **Further New Guidance**

We have received further new guidance regarding children being away from school if there is a positive case identified at home. Below is the latest update from Public Health:

We now advise that if someone at home has tested positive, school-aged children should stay at home and engage in daily LFD testing, returning to school from Day 3 if their Day 1-3 tests have returned negative results. They should continue testing for the full 7 days. Parents/carers who still want their child to continue to attend school have the right for them to do so. This advice does not apply to early years settings, as daily testing is not recommended for under 5s.

# **SIAMS Inspection**

# **Health Update**

Children with simple cold symptoms such as runny noses or sore throats **without fever** should not be tested for COVID-19, and can attend school if they feel well enough to do so.
