Fantastic news girls, well done to all of the players!



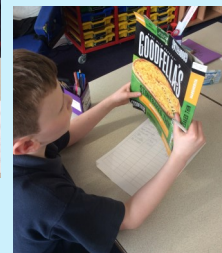
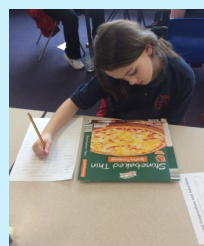
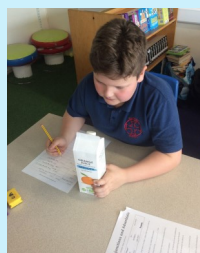
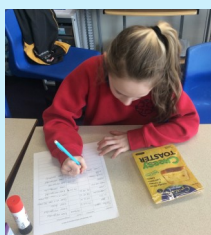
Church Links

Health Update

If your child has symptoms of COVID-19, please keep your child at home and contact school to advise us of any absence.

Public Health latest advice:

Anyone who tests positive for COVID-19 should stay at home for at least 5 and up to 10 days and avoid contact with other people.

Anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 may choose to take a lateral flow test from 5 days after symptoms started (or the day their test was taken if they did not have symptoms) followed by another lateral flow test the next day.

If both these test results are negative, and the person **does not have a high temperature**, they can safely return to the setting before the end of the full, advised 10-day period.
