All of the money raised will be donated to the **Ukraine Crisis Appeal**.

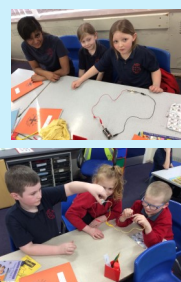
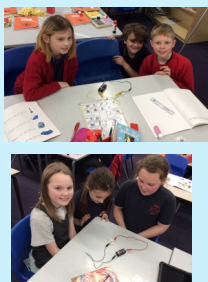
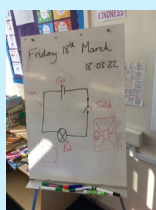


Pupil Permission Forms

Epilepsy Awareness Day

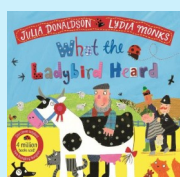

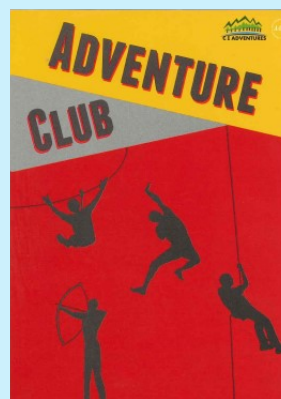
