Next week, children will spend Monday Tuesday and Wednesday morning in their new class. This is a great opportunity to begin to get to know their new class staff.

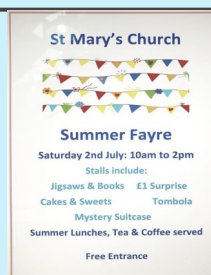
Elland Carnival

This week in Collective Worship Lynn Lord spoke to the children about Service and how to explore and encourage kindness.



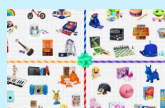
Year 4

It is a great opportunity to develop skills in Maths and English which might lead to employment and the ability to support children better with their learning.

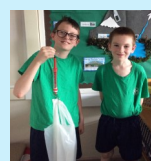
Assessment is undertaken prior to enrolment to explore the learner's current skills level and learners will be advised which starting point best meets their needs.

Health Update

If your child has symptoms of COVID-19, please keep your child at home and contact school to advise us of any absence.

Public Health latest advice:

Anyone who tests positive for COVID-19 should stay at home for at least 5 and up to 10 days and avoid contact with other people.

Anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 may choose to take a lateral flow test from 5 days after symptoms started (or the day their test was taken if they did not have symptoms).

After the 5 days, if the person feels well and **does not have a high temperature**, they can safely return to the setting.
