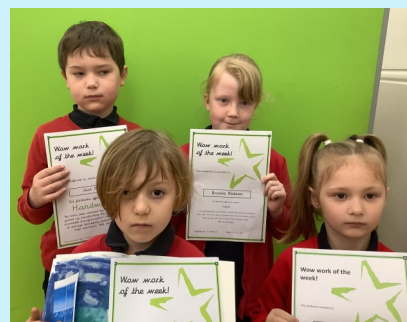

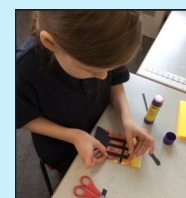


Creative Art Club

Health Update

NHS latest advice:
