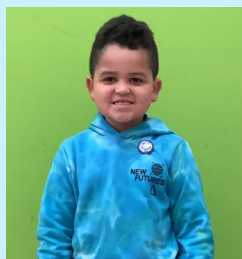

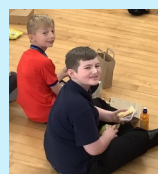


## Celebration Assembly and Parent Coffee Morning

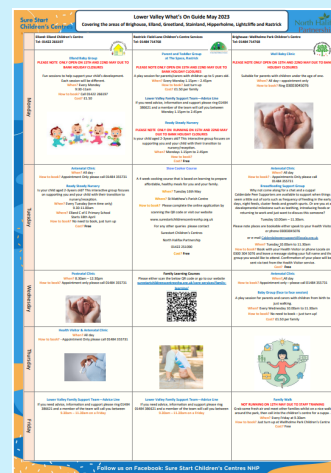
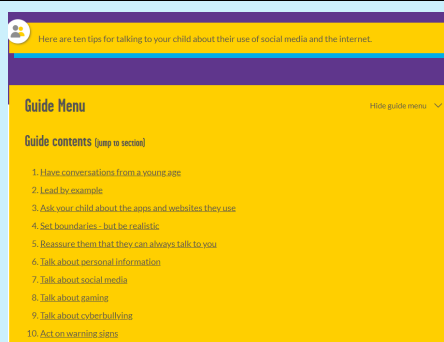
The children have been looking at human rights, managing stress, responsibilities and how to keep safe. Tom looked at the work the children had completed and brought the children some goodies.
