

You will be sent a message and able to book an appointment for this on the SchoolPing app from Wednesday 28th February.




Church Links

Whilst we were doing our busy jobs, some students decided to create a boat fit for an Emperor Penguin travelling to Antarctica.


The children explored using wooden blocks to build their structure. We then added a jug of water to the model to see how sustainable wood would be during a long journey to Antarctica.
